## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST OCS-EOI-01-2021

# **REGISTERED LAND SURVEYORS**

The Office of the Chief Secretary (OCS), Tobago House of Assembly (THA) hereby invites legally registered vendors specialized in Land Surveying services to survey lands as part of the **OCS Farmland Development Program 2021**.

The OCS hereby seeks prospective short-term entities who possessed the capacity as Contractor Licensed Surveyors to provide *cadastral, topographical and engineering* survey services for lands under the purview of the Tobago House of Assembly at the following:

- a. Friendship Estate for Agricultural Development
- b. Friendship Estate for Recreational/Commercial Development
- c. Lammy Road, Argyle for Agricultural Development

Duly registered entities including those already prequalified with the Procurement Control Office under the category of Land Surveyors <u>MUST</u> also meet the following criteria:

Surveyor/Contractor <u>MUST</u> be domiciled in the island of Tobago. Proof must be presented that the interested party's business/partnership/company is domiciled (living, residing, operating) on the island of Tobago. Contractor <u>MUST</u> present any of the following bill: WASA/T&TEC/ Telephone or other bill in the name of the business/partnership/company.

Surveyor/Contractor <u>MUST</u> be Prequalified with the Procurement Control Office to execute land surveying services to the THA. Prequalification documents can be downloaded from PCO's web portal at <u>www.pco.tha.gov.tt</u> and submitted to the Procurement Control Office.

Surveyor/Contractor **MUST** be a registered Land Surveyor registered with the Land Survey Board of Trinidad and Tobago (LSBTT) or have in its employ a Surveyor registered with the LSBTT.

Surveyor/Contractor **MUST** provide proof of ownership or access to the necessary equipment to complete the job in the time given.

Surveyor/Contractor <u>MUST</u> have proof of at least five (5) years' experience in surveying large acreage of lands (30 acres minimum). Surveyor/Contractor should agree to facilitate a physical site visit if necessary to verify the lands they state they have surveyed.

Applicants <u>MUST</u> provide two (2) recommendations from clients for whom surveying services were executed successfully within the last five (5) years.
