UPDATE OF PRE-QUALIFICATION LIST

ASPHALT & CONCRETE ROAD PAVING (15-PCO-017)

The Procurement Control Office, Office of the Chief Secretary (OCS), Tobago House of Assembly (THA) is desirous of identifying and updating our current list of registered contractors in the category RE: Asphalt Paving, Road Construction and Supplies (15-PCO-017). This category has been renamed: **Asphalt & Concrete Road Paving**.

The aim of this update is to identify contractors on the island of Tobago with the plant, equipment, financial capacity, personnel and experience in asphalt and concrete road paving. Deriving out from this exercise, an updated list of bonded contractors can be forwarded for approval by the THA for works of that nature.

Duly registered entities including vendors already prequalified with the Procurement Control Office under the category **MUST** also apply to meet the following criteria:

ASPHALT PAVING

1. Domicile in the island of Tobago.
2. Prequalified to execute road construction works above the low 8-digit category (more specifically - greater than TT\$10M) in a calendar year with the PCO, THA.
3. Proof of ownership or access to a functioning asphalt hotmix batching plant in the island of Tobago.
4. Proof of ownership or access to aggregate materials necessary for the production of asphalt hotmix in the island of Tobago.
5. Proof of ownership or access to the following minimum pieces of equipment (pictures and registration information for each item will be required):
 - 4no. 5.4 cu. M. dump trucks
 - 1no. Motor Grader
 - 1no. Motor Spreader with pulsar ultrasonic self-levelling features (or equivalent)
 - 1no. 11-ton roller compactor
 - 1no. 3ton roller compactor with self-watering features
 - 1no. Water truck
 - 1no. Backhoe
 - 1no. Bituminous oil cart
6. Experienced road construction and asphalt hotmix paving labour force which will have to be identified via signed resume for ALL members of one of their standard paving operations team and supplemented by company organizational structure details.
7. Access to Cationic Bitumen Emulsions (e.g. Lake Asphalt of Trinidad and Tobago (1978) Limited's range of Cationic Bitumen Emulsions), or equivalent.

8. Access to Trinidad Lake Asphalt (TLA) thermoplastic (viscoelastic) bituminous material, or equivalent.
9. Any pertinent certifications relevant to road resurfacing project implementation.
10. Proof of at least five (5) years' experiences in conducting road construction works in the island of Tobago supported by projects of total cost above TT\$10M in a calendar year, with at least two (2) client references.
11. Copies of signed contract(s) for road construction and asphalt works with total cost greater than TT\$10M and successfully completed in the last year in the island of Tobago.

ROAD PAVING

1. Domicile in the island of Tobago.
2. Prequalified to execute road construction works above the low 8-digit category (more specifically - greater than TT\$30M) in a calendar year with the PCO, THA.
3. Proof of at least five (5) years' experiences in conducting concrete road construction works in the island of Tobago supported by concrete road surface projects of total cost above TT\$30M in a calendar year, with at least two (2) client references.
4. Proof of ownership or access to a functioning concrete batching plant in the island of Tobago capable of producing fibre-reinforced, Grade 25N/mm² concrete.
5. Proof of ownership or access to aggregate materials necessary for the production of structural, fibre-reinforced concrete in the island of Tobago.
6. Copies of signed contract(s) for road construction and concrete wearing course works with total cost greater than TT\$30M and successfully completed in the last year in the island of Tobago.
7. Proof of ownership or access to the following minimum pieces of equipment (pictures and registration information for each item will be required):
 - a. 4no. 6.0 cu. M. concrete trucks
 - b. 1no. Concrete line pump (or truck)
 - c. 1no. Motor Grader
 - d. 1no. 3ton roller compactor with self-watering features
 - e. 1no. Water truck
 - f. 1no. Backhoe
8. Any pertinent certifications relevant to road resurfacing project implementation.
